

# Jarrylo™



## American

**Origin:** Named for the Slavic god of fertility, Jarrylo™ (*pronounced Jar-ril-lo*) is a dwarf variety bred by the American Dwarf Hop Association. Its parentage includes Summit and other ADHA varieties.

**Usage:** Jarrylo™ can be used as a dual purpose hop thanks to its high alpha content, but its big oil fraction (particularly humulene and myrcene) and unique aromatics make it very well-suited to late, whirlpool, or dry hop additions for pales and IPAs, saisons, and other hop-forward Belgian styles.

**Aroma & Flavor Characteristics:** Strong tones of fruit (banana, pear, melon, orange) with spicy and grassy notes.

**Maturity:** Early to mid-Season
