## New Zealand

**Origin:** New Zealand. A triploid variety from HortResearch, bred from a selection of New Zealand breeding stock and Saazer. Motueka brings a winning combination of noble heritage with southern hemisphere fruit.

**Usage:** Primarily aroma, but can easily be used as a dual-purpose hop. Its mixture of Saaz character with distinct lemon-lime citrus plus good oil content makes for a unique signature when used throughout the kettle in hoppy lagers, Belgian ales, or wheat beers.

**Aroma & Flavor Characteristics:** Sweet and resinous with zingy citrus and fresh herbal notes (basil, rosemary) and hints of dried orchard fruit around the edges.

**Maturity:** Early

**Yield:** Low to medium
