Origin: Waimea is a dual purpose hop bred and released in 2012. Known for vigorous growth, Waimea claims parentage from Californian Late Cluster, Fuggle and Saaz.

Usage: Aroma. Waimea's typically high alpha acid levels give it considerable bittering potential, but it is most prized for its high oil content (particularly myrcene), low cohumulone, and aromatic impact in the glass.

Aroma & Flavor Characteristics: Outsized and assertive with citrus fruit (think tangerine/orange) and pine needles for days.

Maturity: Mid to late-season

Yield: Moderate to high
