

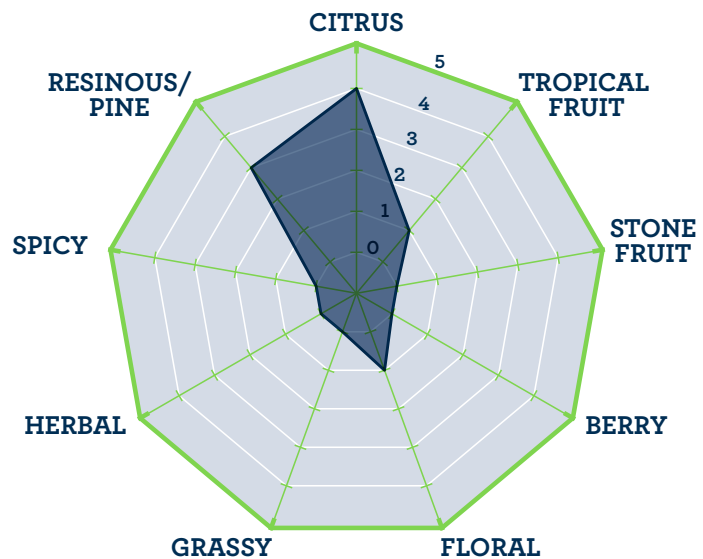
# WAIMEA™

New Zealand



**Origin:** Waimea™ is a dual purpose hop bred and released in 2012. Known for vigorous growth, Waimea™ claims parentage from Californian Late Cluster, Fuggle and Saaz.

**Usage:** Aroma. Waimea's typically high alpha acid levels give it considerable bittering potential, but it is most prized for its high oil content (particularly myrcene), low co-humulone, and aromatic impact in the glass.




**Aroma & Flavor Characteristics:** Bold and assertive with citrus fruit (think tangerine/orange) and pine needles for days.
